Martin Daniel Britt of Ocean Springs, Mississippi, formerly of D'Iberville, Mississippi, passed from this life on Friday, September 6, 2019 in Ocean Springs Hospital surrounded by his family. Martin was born March 10, 1960 to Daniel M. and Lucy E. Britt. He was a pastor serving at Parkway Baptist Church. Martin formerly worked at the Home of Grace in Vancleave and was a counselor for 16 years where he touched thousands of lives. Prior to that he was assistant manager along the Gulf Coast at Delchamps Grocery. His most proud accomplishments were his writings on Spiritual Warfare and his Warriors program at Parkway Baptist where he worked with children. He was passionate about his praise and worship music and he knew how to worship. He loved Spanish history and wrote a book on the Spanish history in the Mississippi sound. His legacy will live on in the lives of the children that he taught in his Warrior program and his teachings throughout his six years of service as pastor.
